Will the federation have trials or qualifications?

The Federation has selected the first option which is a combination of trials and qualifications (65% based on the rankings of the 2023 season for athletes, and this ranking takes into account the results of athletes inside the Kingdom in approved meets/championships organized by the Athletics Federation or others such as the Armed Forces championships, or outside the Kingdom in meets/championships approved by World Athletics), 25% based on the September 2023 trials (two trials) and 10% reserved for the organizing committee (wild card).*

Are trials for the general public and club athletes, or are they restricted to club athletes only?

The trials are open to the public and club players alike. The public can participate in the auditions and achieve qualification, as well as players (who did not qualify based on the 2023 season classification) can participate in the auditions and achieve qualification.

Are qualifications for the general public and club athletes, or they are restricted to club athletes only?

Restricted to club athletes only.

*: The 800-meter, discus throw, and hammer throw events are excluded from the trials. Qualifications will rely solely on the top performances of the 2023 season (90%) plus two wild cards (10%) for the Organizing Committee of the Saudi Games.

Terms and Conditions – Athletics

Conditions and requirements that must be met by male and female athletes who wish to participate in the trials for seniors:

1. Must be a Saudi national; or

A resident with a valid residence permit (Iqama); or

Born in Saudi; or

Born to a Saudi mother.

2. Any athlete older than 16 y/o (born 2007 and older) can participate with the following exception (no throwing events for those born in 2007 & 2006).

3. For the general public (those who are not registered in government sports clubs) and wish to participate in the trials, the athlete must be medically fit and MUST bring a medical form as proof on the day of the trials. No one will be allowed to participate without the athlete's medical form.

4. Club athletes who wish to participate in the trials must bring their club IDs.

5. Participants must wear the correct attire for the activity.

6. Suspended athletes by national or international panels are not allowed to participate.

7. Two trials will be held in two different regions throughout the Kingdom. It is not allowed to participate in more than one trial. Athletes are only allowed to participate in one.

Conditions and requirements that must be met by male and female athletes who wish to participate in the trials for juniors:

1. Must be a Saudi national; or

A resident with a valid residence permit (Iqama); or

Born in Saudi; or

Born to a Saudi mother.

2. Only athletes aged 16, 17, 18 or 19 on 31 December 2023 (born in 2007, 2006, 2005 or 2004) may compete. Athletes younger than 16 (born 2008 and younger cannot participate).

3. For the general public (those who are not registered in government sports clubs) and wish to participate in the trials, the athlete must be medically fit and MUST bring a medical form as proof on the day of the trials. No one will be allowed to participate without the athlete's medical form.

4. Club athletes who wish to participate in the trials must bring their club IDs.

5. Participants must wear the correct attire for the activity.

6. Suspended athletes by national or international panels are not allowed to participate.

7. Two trials will be held in two different regions throughout the Kingdom. It is not allowed to participate in more than one trial. Athletes are only allowed to participate in one.

8. In the event that there is the same event for men and women or for boys and girls (100m for example), the athlete must choose one event only. It is not possible to participate in both categories (seniors and juniors of the same event).
